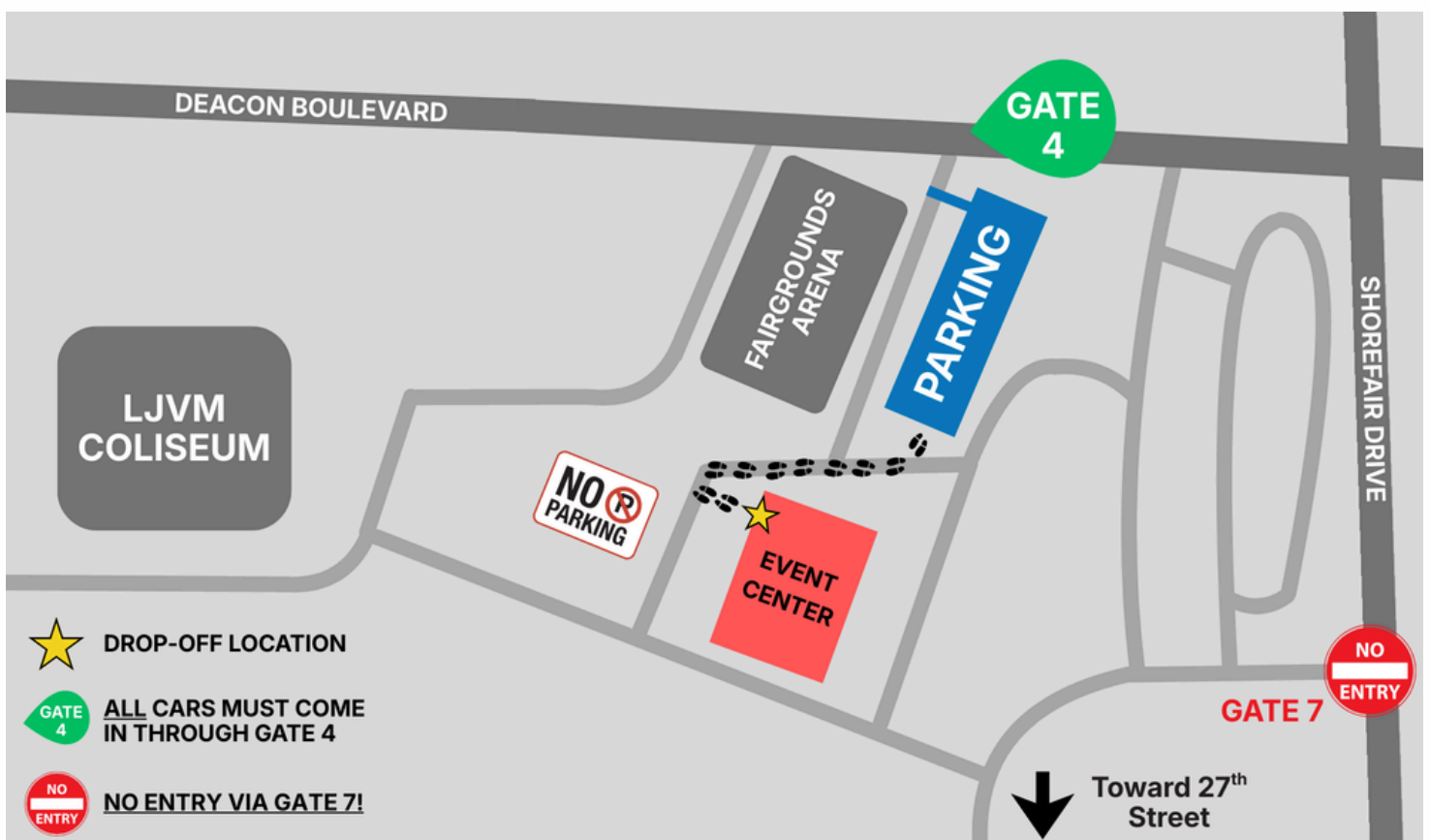
DROP-OFF INFORMATION

- Drop-off for **CULINARY** exhibits is:
 - **Friday, September 25 from 4 to 8 p.m.**
 - **Saturday, September 26 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.**
 - **Sunday, September 27 from 12 to 4 p.m.**
- If you have entries for other departments, you may have a separate drop-off date. Please read each department's rules and guidelines when entering.
- Do **NOT** remove the claim check portion; you will need this to pick up your exhibit(s).

PICK-UP INFORMATION

- Pick-up for ALL exhibits is: **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**
 - **Monday, October 12 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.**
 - **Tuesday, October 13 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.**
- You **MUST** have your claim check tag to reclaim your entry, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Exhibits cannot be removed prior to October 12.
- **All items will be discarded after October 13.**

FAQs & ENTRY INFORMATION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will I receive my entry tag(s)? Entry tags will be mailed after September 1.

Where do I go to drop off my exhibit(s)? Please come in Gate 4 and follow signs. See the map on page 2.

Where will my exhibit(s) be displayed at the fair? Culinary exhibits are displayed in the Event Center.

Where should I place my tag(s)? Please see page 4.

How should I display my exhibit(s)? Please see Page 4 for photos of correct displays. Exhibits that do not adhere to the guidelines will **NOT** be accepted, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Can I use eggs in my icing? Yes, as long as they are cooked.

Can I enter both Amateur and Professional classes? No, you can only enter one or the other.

Who is considered an Amateur? An Amateur is someone who earns less than 10% of their income from selected craft. Current and past teachers of selected craft are not considered an Amateur.

What if my item(s) start to deteriorate during the Fair? The Fair reserves the right to remove and discard items that are deteriorating.

How do I pick up my exhibit(s) after the fair? All entries must be picked up on **Monday, October 12 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. or Tuesday, October 13 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.** No items will be removed before October 12. All items will be discarded after October 13. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

DISPLAYING YOUR EXHIBIT

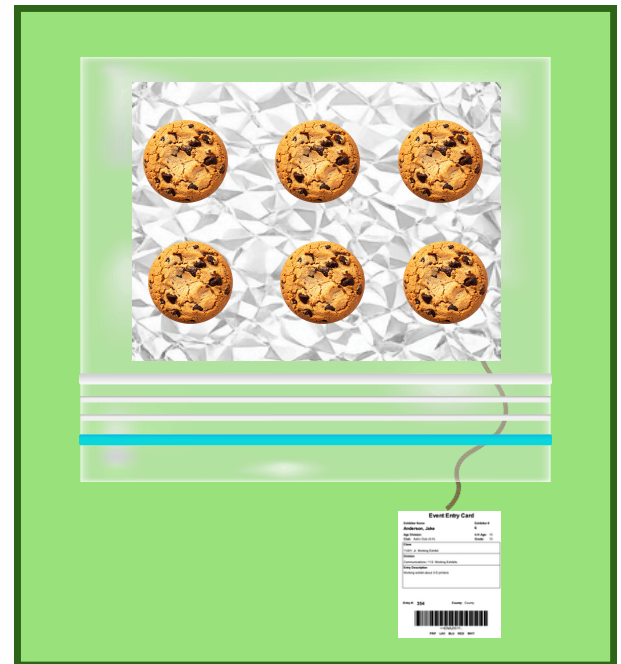
DISPLAYING CAKES *(excludes Decorative Cakes)*

- ✓ Cake is cut in the shape of a semicircle
- ✓ Cake is set on a semicircle-shaped piece of cardboard covered in foil (cardboard must not be larger than 1" more than cake)
- ✓ Cake is in a large, clear plastic bag
- ✓ Entry tag is extending OUTSIDE of the bag (tag strings should be taped to the underside of the cardboard in the lower right-hand corner)



DISPLAYING OTHER CULINARY ITEMS

- ✓ Has the correct amount of the item
- ✓ Item is set on a rectangular-shaped piece of cardboard covered in foil
- ✓ Item is in a large, clear plastic bag
- ✓ Entry tag is extending OUTSIDE of the bag (tag strings should be taped to the underside of the cardboard in the lower right-hand corner)



NOT ACCEPTED

- Plastic or Saran wrap in place of a clear plastic bag
- Cake carriers or personal containers
- Entries that require refrigeration

The Carolina Classic Fair reserves the right to not accept any entries that are not displayed correctly. Exhibitors must provide their own cardboard, aluminum foil, and plastic bags. These items will NOT be available during Drop Off Days. All entries must be prepared for display prior to dropping them off.

PREMIUMS AND AWARDS

- A ribbon is a badge of merit, and in no case should be attached to an article or animal where meritorious qualities are lacking.
- The following colors will be used to designate awards:
 - **Judge's Choice:** Red, White and Blue
 - **First Place:** Blue
 - **Second Place:** Red
 - **Third Place:** White
- If awarded, all ribbons must be picked up following the Fair (October 12-13).
- Premiums will be paid only from the judging results records and **NOT** from the ribbon or tags on exhibits.
- Errors or omissions in premium payments not reported to the Fair Administrative Office by December 31, 2026, will **NOT** be paid.



CATEGORIES: AMATEUR

GOOD QUALITIES

1. Appearance: Pleasing appearance, even golden-brown color, good shape, well-proportioned, even rounded top
2. Texture: Fine, even grain, small thin cell walls, light for size, crisp crust about 1/8" thick
3. Crumb: Even color throughout, slightly moist, light and elastic, tender
4. Flavor: Good well-blended flavor, pleasing

POOR QUALITIES

1. Appearance: Too pale or too brown, irregular or poor shape, has cracks or bulges, hard, dry crust
2. Texture: Large cells, coarse grain, thick cell walls, tunnels or large holes, heavy for size
3. Crumb: Gray or dark streaks, harsh, crumbly, dry, doughy, tough
4. Flavor: Flat tasting, sour fermented flavor, any flavor too strong, off flavor

CAKE JUDGING CRITERIA

GOOD QUALITIES

1. Appearance: Pleasing appearance, slightly rounded top; If unfrosted: smooth, uniform, light brown; If frosted: frosting free from crystals or crustiness
2. Texture: Fine even grain, thin cell walls, feathery light, crumbly when cut
3. Crumb: Smooth and velvety, slightly moist, light and tender, pleasing color
4. Flavor: Delicate, well-blended flavor, sweet flavor, free from strong flavor, tastes good

POOR QUALITIES

1. Appearance: Not pleasing in appearance, peaked or sunken top, cracked, sugary or coarse crust, too sticky, too dry or too coarse frosting, pale or too brown crust stickiness
2. Texture: Thick cell walls, coarse or uneven grain, tunnels or large holes, heavy
3. Crumb: Soggy or sad, harsh or dry, tough, off color
4. Flavor: Bitter, flat, strong flavor of egg, flavoring or other ingredients, unpleasant flavor

CAKE DEFINITIONS

Plain Pound Cake - Any variation of ingredients - butter, sugar, flour, eggs, vanilla flavoring, etc.

Devil's Food Cake - Made with buttermilk and soda

Chocolate Cake - Made with sweet milk and baking powder

Angel Food Cake - White in color - use egg white only - no leavening

The Fair reserves the right to disqualify any cake that does not appear to be of good quality.

GOOD QUALITIES

1. Appearance: crust: color uniform, characteristic of type, shape: regular, even, uniform, good proportion attractive
2. Texture: thin cookies (rolled, ice box, pressed), crisp and tender, thick cookies (drop, sheet or bar), soft and tender, even grain
3. Tenderness: tender, but holds together well
4. Flavor: tastes good, free from excessive flavoring, flavor well-blended, characteristic flavor of kind

POOR QUALITIES

1. Appearance: burned, pale dull color, irregular or poor shape, too large or too small, too thick or too thin
2. Texture: too hard or dry, too limp, coarse grain, heavy or soggy
3. Tenderness: tough, rubbery, crumbly
4. Flavor: too strong taste of flavoring or spices, off flavor

Materials: Only edible products may be used - such as sugar, flour, icing, marzipan, candies, etc. Graham crackers are not allowed. NO ARTIFICIAL MATERIALS ACCEPTED, such as Styrofoam, or lighting in construction of house. Base material is the only exception.

Competition open to Amateur Adults only (18 years and older).

RULES AND GUIDELINES

Decorative icing entries will be judged on DECORATIVE SKILLS ONLY! Do not use cookies, candies, etc. ONLY HANDMADE EDIBLE DECORATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED! NO EXCEPTIONS! DO NOT USE PEARLS OR OTHER NON-EDIBLE DECORATIONS. NO DECORATIVE LINERS. NO PURCHASED OR PRE-MADE CANDY (M&M's, etc.)

Icing display must be shown on an object - foam rubber dummy, Styrofoam, cake, etc. If cake is used, the judges will not cut.

IMPORTANT RULE: Icing display must not exceed a 12" display board (round or square). Maximum height and length is 12." Any icing display not complying with ALL rules, regulations and size limit will be disqualified and not judged.
